The new Assistant/Associate Professor of Management will be responsible for teaching eight courses a year. In addition, the new faculty member will assist with academic projects, advising students, and engaging in curriculum development. The successful candidate must demonstrate excellence in the classroom (on-ground and online) and have experience teaching traditional and non-traditional age students. Continued professional development and scholarly research, as well as undertaking community service in keeping with the University's Benedictine values will be important. Interested candidates must have a doctorate from a regionally accredited institution, with credentials to teach at the undergraduate and graduate level per accreditation guidelines. This position will also service Saint Leo's Columbus Air Force Base Center in Columbus, Mississippi. Military requirements mandate this candidate must be a United States citizen.

Originally, the Center opened its doors in 1995 at the Naval Station Ingleside. The Center expanded due to growing enrollments in 2005, and is now located at the Naval Air Station Corpus Christi. Because of Saint Leo's long-standing relationship with the Military, the Center has a unique blend of military and civilian students. The Naval Air Station Corpus Christi was commissioned in 1941, and in 1944 was the largest naval aviation training facility in the world, covering more than 20,000 acres. Located just six miles from the central business district of Corpus Christi, Texas, the coastal city has a population of more than 300,000, making it the eighth largest city in the state. Situated beside Corpus Christi Bay, the Gulf of Mexico, and Laguna Madre, the city is home to many popular destinations for both tourists and residents.
