The University is currently seeking an experienced administrator to become the new **Dean of the Faculty of Business**. Reporting to the Provost, the successful candidate will be responsible for overseeing a Business school with two departments – Management and Accounting. The Department of Management has ten major concentrations, including Banking, Global and Corporate Finance, Urban Economics, Marketing, Retail Economics, Human Resource Management, Health Science Management, Economics, Entrepreneurship, and International Business. A master's degree in Management is offered on nights and weekends. The Business school is equipped with a clear vision, international standard curriculum, industry driven course content, professional and highly qualified professors, and modern teaching-learning facilities. With more than 1,900 students enrolled (including graduate students), Business is the largest school and the flagship program on campus.

The new Dean will be responsible for overseeing the accreditation of the Business school through the Indonesian Higher Education Authority, as well as supporting the University's co-curricular general education program. Previous administrative experience is essential, and international experience or a high level of cultural sensitivity is preferred. A proven ability to integrate faith and learning in the academic curriculum is required. A doctorate is preferred, however, an MBA with a combination of corporate and academic experience is acceptable. The successful candidate must fully understand and support the University's mission and vision as an evangelical Christian institution. There is a desire to improve the quality and visibility of the program, making this the premier business school in Indonesia.
