Established in 1994 by the Pelita Harapan Foundation, **Universitas Pelita Harapan** (UPH) is a university committed to the noble cause of Christ-centered higher education. UPH enrolls approximately 8,500 students (including more than 600 postgraduate students) in 29 undergraduate and six graduate programs, a law school, and a medical school. The faculty are internationally diverse. The University has multiple campus sites, with the main campus situated on more than 34 acres of land just 12 miles from the capital city of Jakarta. The University is currently seeking an experienced administrator to become the new **Dean of the Conservatory of Music**. Reporting to the Provost, the successful candidate will be responsible for managing a bachelor's degree program that enrolls more than 270 full-time students and supports 13 full-time and 57 part-time lecturers. The Conservatory offers nine major concentrations, including Classical Performance, Music Composition, Music Education, Church Music, Professional Contemporary Music, Music Therapy, Sound Design, Performing Arts Production and Management, and Musicology. All concentrations carry 145 credit hours of music and liberal arts courses.

The new Dean will be responsible for overseeing the accreditation of the Conservatory through the Indonesian Higher Education Authority, as well as supporting the University's co-curricular general education program. Broad experience in undergraduate music programs and sufficient familiarity with graduate music programs is required. Previous administrative experience is essential, and international experience or a high level of cultural sensitivity is preferred. A proven ability to integrate faith and learning in the academic curriculum is necessary. An earned doctorate in music or a closely related field is mandatory. The successful candidate must fully understand and support the University's mission and vision as an evangelical Christian institution.
