The University is currently seeking an experienced administrator to become the new **Dean of the Faculty of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences**. Reporting to the Provost, the successful candidate will be responsible for overseeing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing program that enrolls approximately 200 full-time students. The curriculum is developed as a blending of national and international standards. With a strong clinical component, students undertake clinical placements each semester.

The new Dean will be responsible for overseeing the accreditation of the Nursing school through the Indonesian Higher Education Authority, as well as supporting the University's co-curricular general education program. Broad experience in nursing education and in a clinical setting is required. Previous administrative experience is essential, and international experience or a high level of cultural sensitivity is preferred. A proven ability to integrate faith and learning in the academic curriculum is required. A doctorate is preferred, however, a master's degree and significant real-world experience is acceptable. The successful candidate must fully understand and support the University's mission and vision as an evangelical Christian institution.
